What Will You Sacrifice?

Consider what it means to be made right with God because of Christ (Romans 3:22). May our hearts meditate on our blessed relationship with God, by the power of His Holy Spirit because of our Savior, Jesus Christ. And, let our acts of love, justice, kindness, and compassion for all humankind reflect our gratitude for our salvation because of Christ's sacrifice.

Ash Wednesday, March 5, 2025, begins the 40-day Lenten season (excluding Sundays) that runs through Thursday (Maundy Thursday), April 17, 2025. Lent is a period of prayer and fasting in Christian traditions to remember the sinless life and suffering of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. After 40 days of deep reflection and consideration of our need for repentance and the seriousness of sin, we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ, Easter Sunday (April 20, 2025)! Because of the great sacrifice of our Lord Jesus by dying on a cross for our sins, we have the right to eternal life (Romans 5:10, I Peter 2:24, John 3:16).

During Lent, consider what you will sacrifice (give up) in observance and reverence of Jesus' sacrifice to redeem those who would believe in Him back to God (Ephesians 1:7).

Let the Lenten Season Begin!

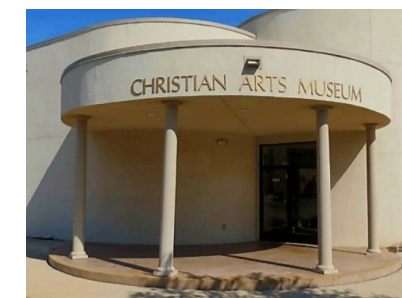

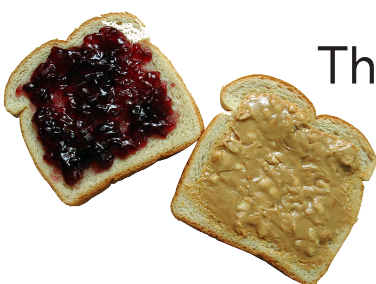
